

Hotspot update: September 9, 2019

On Monday September 9, at 3.50 pm, four hotspots were detected within our concession under PT Harapan Sawit Lestari in Kalimantan Barat. We subsequently verified that actual the fire started in an enclaved area owned by the local community. Cargill does not own these enclaved areas and we do not have the jurisdiction over the actions of local communities on these lands. As the embers carried by the wind, the fire quickly spread to our own concession despite our fire-fighting team's efforts to contain the fire. More information on the damage will be forthcoming.
